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## World Geography (1 of 2)

## Course Description:

This course explores the geography, history, religion, and customs of cultures around the world. The geographic focus will include the study of physical and political maps, resources, and migration patterns. You will study the five themes of geography and the basic soil, water, and air systems of the earth and how they impact both physical and human geography. Next, is the geographical, social, economic, and political factors that influence North, Central, and South America and their interaction with the world. Europe, Russia, and Central Asia are also explored both regionally and globally. Your final grades are based on your ability to show what you have learned through a variety of assessment types: workbook questions, discussion boards, checkpoints, a final exam, and a multi-step project.

### Course Objectives:

- Analyze cultural changes in specific regions caused by migration, war, trade, innovations, and diffusion.
- Analyze how the character of a place is related to its political, economic, social, and cultural elements.
- Analyze political reasons that lead to the formation of boundaries.
- Analyze regional issues in different parts of the world that have critical economic, physical, or political ramifications.
- Connect current events to the physical and human characteristics of places and regions.
- Describe how the components of culture, including language, religion, beliefs, institutions, and technologies, shape the characteristics of regions.
- Explain how distinctive cultural landscapes influenced diffusion.
- Explain how physical characteristics of place (landforms, bodies of water, climate, natural resources) act as contributing factors to world settlement patterns.
- Explain the complexity of the earth's cultural mosaic.
- Identify physical and/or human factors that constitute a region.
- Identify physical characteristics of a location.
- Interpret data from maps, graphs, tables, and charts.
- Research and synthesize evidence to create original writing and graphics.
