

### Course Description:

Kindergarten Language Arts provides a structured introduction to the elements of language for beginning learners and readers. The approach to phonics systematically and explicitly teaches each phoneme and then allows students to make connections with the written graphemes and sounds. This learning is then applied as they begin to read short stories and poems.

This course also begins to build reading comprehension for young readers. They can explore concepts of characters, setting, and events in fiction, and main idea and key details in nonfiction texts. The interactive storybook readers allow students to have the story read aloud to them as they build reading and comprehension skills. Assessments support understanding of skills and concepts by providing feedback as students answer.

### Course Objectives:

- Identify and write uppercase and lowercase letters.

- Have a conversation by asking and answering questions.
- Identify characters, setting, and events in a story.
- Make connections between the words and pictures in a story.
- Use question words (who, what, when, where, why, how).
- Read and write sight words.
- Read words by blending beginning, middle, and end sounds.
- Spell words using letter sounds.
- Change letter sounds to make and spell new words.
- Make connections between the words and pictures in a story.
- Compare and contrast what characters do in different stories.
- Make text-to-self connections.
- Identify the topic and retell important details of a text.
- Read grade level text independently.
- Identify, use, and sort verbs and nouns.
- Use capitalization and punctuation correctly in sentences.
- Make complete sentences with pronouns.
- Write an opinion piece about your favorite book with a topic sentence, details, and a drawing.
- Use technology to turn in your writing piece.
- Actively participate in group reading activities.
