## **Course Description:**

Career Explorations (1 of 1) provides instruction and practice about various topics in the world of work. These topics include jobs, careers, labor markets, traditional and nontraditional occupational roles, ethical and unethical behavior, educational pathways to careers, budgeting, communication in the workplace, and technology in the workplace. There is a short project on problem-solving skills as well as a project on searching for a job, preparing a resume and cover letter, and interviewing for a job.

## **Course Objectives:**

- Identify personal abilities, interests, and motivations that influence job and career selection.
- Identify labor market information for jobs based on skill, wage, and demand.
- Explain how jobs tend to be distributed regionally, nationally, and globally using labor market information.
- Identify common knowledge, skills, abilities, and certifications needed within various career clusters.
- Identify types of secondary opportunities (for example, co-curricular, extracurricular, extended learning).
- Describe how specific traditional and nontraditional occupational roles have changed or remained the same regionally, nationally, and globally.
- Explain an individual's responsibility for their personal actions and contributions to group activities.
- Identify ethical and unethical behavior.
- Identify problem-solving strategies that can be used to solve a problem in school or in real-world situations.
- Explain common wants and needs and their factors.
- Describe educational pathways (for example, trade schools, community college).
- Identify elements of a budget and create and evaluate a budget
- Explain how compromise, negotiation, and community-building strategies can be used for a task, assignment, or project.
- Identify strategies for understanding others' verbal and nonverbal communication.
- Describe how communication can change based on culture and generations.
- Describe appropriate work habits and interpersonal skills needed to obtain and retain employment.
- Describe the role of technology in the workplace.
- Explain how technology impacts skills and jobs in the workplace.
- Distinguish industry-recognized technology tools based on their purpose.
- Engage in positive, safe, legal, and ethical behaviors when using technology.
